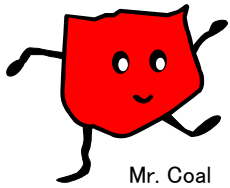
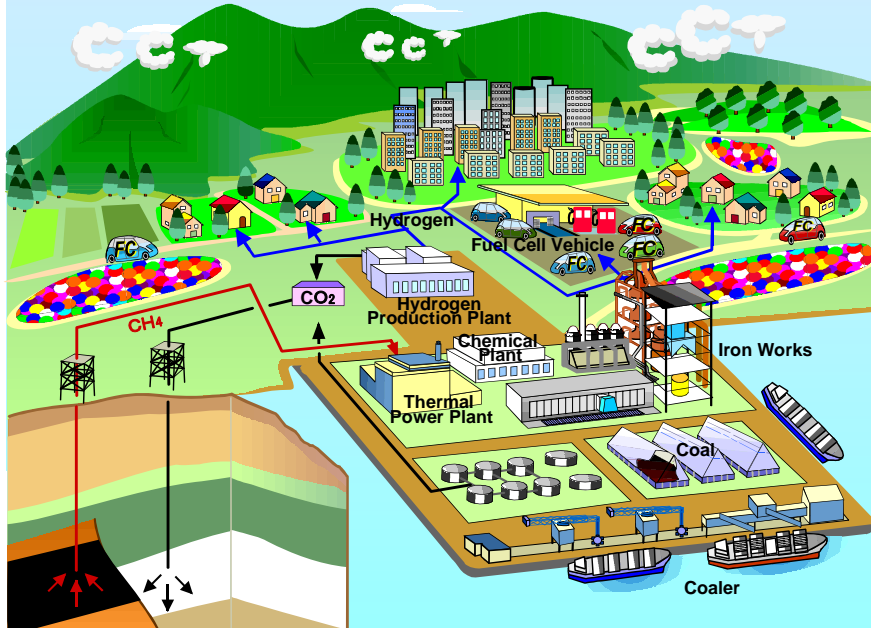

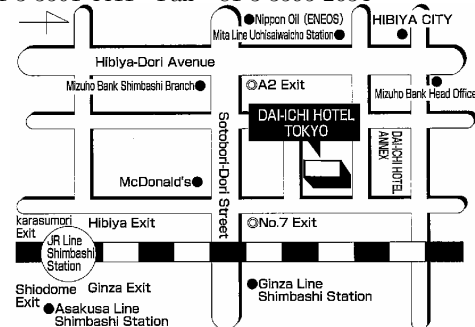
Foreword
