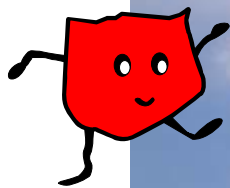

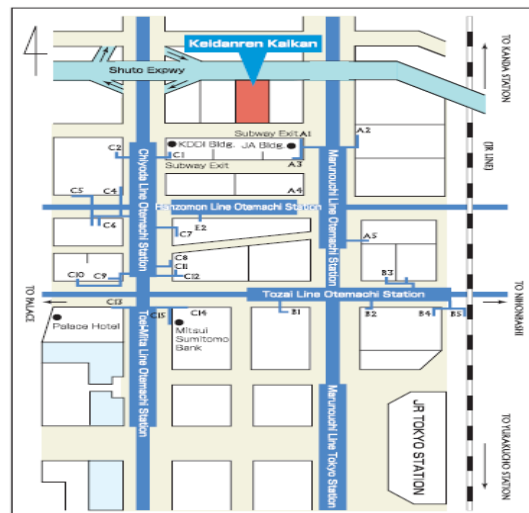
FOREWORD
